

Safety Commitment

Vehicle Check ど Identification

02

A safe ride begins with a pretrip vehicle check. As a driver, you must ensure that your vehicle is clean and in good working condition and equipped with all necessary safety features before servicing a trip. You'll also receive a windshield decal for identification and will need to display the route number on the white erase board that will be provided to you if it hasn't been provided already.

Proper Securement

03

Safety starts with proper securement of all passengers. Make sure everyone (including yourself as the driver) is wearing their seatbelt, and if needed, use car seats, booster seats. Do not operate the vehicle until everyone is properly secured.

Impaired Driving

04

Under no circumstances should you drive if your ability to do so is impaired by fatigue, illness, or any other reason. Your safety, the passengers', and others on the road should always be a priority.

Authorized Passengers and Stops

Only the assigned driver, and trainces should be in the vehicle while servicing the route. Avoid leaving children unattended, and ensure authorized adults receive and release students at pick-up and drop-off locations. {Namely, home or school, and in some cases a day care facility}{DO NOT TRANSPORT THE CHILDREN WITH ANY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONS IN YOUR VEHICLE} **Cellphone Usage**

Cell phones should not be used while the vehicle is in motion unless for necessary calls using hands-free devices. Complete all necessary steps in the **EverDriven driver** application while safely parked. {Drivers should avoid discussing their private life and personal matters around the students they drive to school to maintain a professional and safe environment. Engaging in such conversations can lead to distractions, compromised boundaries, and potential discomfort for the students. ensuring that the focus remains on providing a secure and comfortable transportation experience.

Prompt & Proper Driver App Usage

Prohibited Behavior

Certain behaviors are strictly prohibited, such as violation of safety procedures. inappropriate physical contact, late arrivals to pickups, transporting unauthorized persons, smoking or vaping while on duty/transporting students, and any form of harassment. **WE DO NOT TOUCH THE CHILDREN; THE PARENTS** AND SCHOOL STAFF ARE **TO COME OUT AND** SECURE THE CHILDREN **INTO THE CAR SEAT AND SEATBELT**

DO LOG INTO YOU EVERDRIVEN APP ON TIME



DO COMMUNICATE IMMEDIATELY WITH MANAGERS WHEN DELAYS OR ACCIDENTS OCCUR

DO ALWAYS MAKE SURE THE PARENT OR SCHOOL STAFF HAS PROPERLY SECURED THE STUDENT BEFORE DEPARTURE



DO CHECK YOUR VEHICLE EVERYDAY FOR CLEANLINESS AND PROPER FUNCTION.

DO MAKE SURE YOU PERFORM EVERY TRIP ON TIME IN THE EVERDRIVEN DRIVER APP



DO ALWAYS REMAIN PROFESSIONAL WITH EVERYONE YOU COME IN CONTACT WITH

DO DROP STUDENTS OFF ONLY AT THE ASSIGNED SCHOOL OR HOME.



DO REMEMBER HOW YOU LOOK, TALK AND ACT REFLECT ON THE COMPANY YOU REPRESENT.



DO NOT TALK OR TEXT ON YOUR PHONE WHEN TRANSPORTING STUDENTS



DO NOT TOUCH THE STUDENTS UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCE, OTHER THAN A LIFE-SAVING EMERGENCY



DO NOT USE THREATENING OR OFFENSIVE LANUGUAGE



DO NOT SMOKE, VAPE WHILE TRANSPORTING, AT SCHOOLS OR STUDENTS HOME



DO NOT TRANSPORT STUNDENTS WHILE IMPAIRED, EITHER DUE TO ILLINESS, FATIGUE OR ANY OTHER IMPAIRMENT



DO NOT HARASS OR ATTACK ANYONE FOR ANY REASON

DO NOT CONTINUOUSLY ARRIVE LATE TO SCHOOL PICK UPS



DO NOT TRANSPORT ANYONE ELSE IN THE VEHICLE WHILE TRANSPORTING STUDENTS.

SPECIAL NOTES:

SOME SCHOOLS REQUIRE DRIVERS TO HAVE THEIR VEHICLES EMERGENCY FLASHERS ON EITHER AT ALL TIMES ON SCHOOL GROUNDS OR ONLY WHEN DROPPING STUDENTS OFF AT SCHOOL. <u>(PLEASE</u> <u>COOPERATE WITH THE SCHOOL STAFF)</u> IT IS A GOOD PRACTICE TO HAVE YOUR EMERGENCY FLASHERS ON WHEN DROPPING STUDENTS OFF AT SCHOOL AND AT THEIR HOMES. <u>ALWAYS</u> HAVE YOUR WHITEBOARD WITH THE CORRECT ROUTE NUMBER DISPLAYED PROPERLY, WHICH INDICATES WHO YOU ARE PICKING UP AT THE SCHOOL.
