

Bible Study: “Uncancelled: God’s Love Won’t Let Go”

(Romans 8:31–39, KJV)

Main Idea

Because God is for you in Christ, you don’t have to live scared, ashamed, or defeated—nothing can separate you from His love.

Romans 8:31 (KJV) — God is for me

“*What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us?*” (**Romans 8:31**)

- **Breakdown:** When you feel outnumbered—haters, pressure, anxiety—God’s “for you” outweighs what’s against you.
- **Scriptural support:**
 - “*The LORD is on my side; I will not fear: what can man do unto me?*” (**Psalm 118:6**)
 - “*Fear thou not; for I am with thee...*” (**Isaiah 41:10**)

Romans 8:32 (KJV) — If God gave Jesus, He won’t quit on me

“*He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?*” (**Romans 8:32**)

- **Breakdown:** If God already gave His best (His Son), you can trust Him with what you need today.
- **Scriptural support:**
 - “*For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son...*” (**John 3:16**)
 - “*But my God shall supply all your need...*” (**Philippians 4:19**)

Romans 8:33 (KJV) — God's verdict beats people's accusations

“Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth.” (Romans 8:33)

- **Breakdown:** People can bring receipts, screenshots, and rumors—but God can justify you through Christ.
- **Scriptural support:**
 - *“There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus...” (Romans 8:1)*
 - *“If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive...” (1 John 1:9)*

Romans 8:34 (KJV) — Jesus shuts down condemnation and prays for me

“Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.” (Romans 8:34)

- **Breakdown:** The loudest voice over your life isn't shame—Jesus died, rose, reigns, and intercedes for you.
- **Scriptural support:**
 - *“Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost... seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.” (Hebrews 7:25)*
 - *“My little children... we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous.” (1 John 2:1)*

Romans 8:35 (KJV) — Trouble can't unplug Christ's love

“Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?” (Romans 8:35)

- **Breakdown:** Hard seasons don't mean God stopped loving you. Pressure doesn't equal abandonment.
- **Scriptural support:**
 - *"When thou passest through the waters, I will be with thee..." (Isaiah 43:2)*
 - *"Many are the afflictions of the righteous: but the LORD delivereth him out of them all." (Psalm 34:19)*

Romans 8:36 (KJV) — God's people sometimes suffer, but it's not pointless

"As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter." (Romans 8:36)

- **Breakdown:** Being faithful can cost you—mocked, pressured, misunderstood—but suffering doesn't cancel your calling.
- **Scriptural support:**
 - *"Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution." (2 Timothy 3:12)*
 - *"If ye be reproached for the name of Christ, happy are ye..." (1 Peter 4:14)*

Romans 8:37 (KJV) — I don't just survive; I overcome

"Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us." (Romans 8:37)

- **Breakdown:** The situation may be real, but God's love makes you stronger than what you're facing.
- **Scriptural support:**
 - *"For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world..." (1 John 5:4)*

- “I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.”
(Philippians 4:13)

Romans 8:38 (KJV) — No power can out-muscle God’s love

“For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come,”
(Romans 8:38)

- **Breakdown:** Your biggest fears—now or later—are stronger than God’s hold on you.
- **Scriptural support:**
 - “The LORD shall fight for you...” **(Exodus 14:14)**
 - “Greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.” **(1 John 4:4)**

Romans 8:39 (KJV) — Nothing can separate me from God’s love in Christ

“Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.”
(Romans 8:39)

- **Breakdown:** Not success, not failure, not mental lows, not spiritual warfare—nothing can break God’s love connection in Christ.
- **Scriptural support:**
 - “I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.” **(Hebrews 13:5)**
 - “Having loved his own... he loved them unto the end.”
(John 13:1)
