

Title: “Mission Mode: Jesus Has All the Power”

(Matthew 28:16–20, KJV)

1. Big Idea

- Jesus is the **Leader with all power** and **you’re on His team**.
 - Even if you feel **shy, unsure, or doubting**, He still calls **you**.
 - Your **career, family, friends, and social media** are your mission field.
 - You are **not alone**—He is with you **always, everywhere**.

2. Real-World Breakdown

Matthew 28:16-17 (KJV)

16 Then the eleven disciples went away into Galilee, into a mountain where Jesus had appointed them. 17 And when they saw him, they worshipped him: but some doubted.

- The disciples saw the risen Jesus... and **still some doubted**.
 - Real talk:
 - You can **love God** and still have **questions**.
 - Jesus doesn’t cancel you for doubting; He **meets you there**.
 - Life connection:
 - You can show up to church, ministry/life group, or Bible study feeling:
 - “Is God really listening?”
 - “Why is my life still hard?”
 - Jesus still **includes you** in His mission.

Matthew 28:18 (KJV)

And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

- Jesus is basically saying: “**I run this. Heaven and earth.**”
- That means:
 - Stronger than **romantic-relationship drama**.
 - Stronger than **family problems**.
 - Stronger than **peer pressure, anxiety, and your past**.
- Life connection:
 - Other people have **opinions**; Jesus has **all power**.
 - You don’t live for clout; you live for the **King with real authority**.

Matthew 28:19 (KJV)

Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

- “Go” = Don’t just **sit and scroll**, **move with purpose**.
 - “Teach all nations” = Start where you are:
 - **Your school/job**
 - **Life-group chat**
 - **Your team / club / job**
 - You don’t need a mic or a pulpit:
 - Your **attitude** teaches.
 - Your **kindness** teaches.
 - Your **standards** teach.
 - “Baptizing them...” = Help people **publicly choose Jesus**, not just secretly “like” Him.

Matthew 28:20 (KJV)

Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen.

- “Observe” = **Live it out**, not just **know it in your head**.
 - Jesus is saying:
 - When you’re the **only one** not laughing at the nasty joke: ***I am with you.***
 - When you say **no** to what everybody else is doing: ***I am with you.***
 - When you share Jesus and feel awkward: ***I am with you.***
 - “Even unto the end of the world” = There is **no day, no place, no situation** where He drops you.
