

# Pecos Ground Rules

Sul Ross University will be hosting the Pecos College Rodeo April 9-11. The Rodeo will be held at the Buck Jackson Arena. Performances will start at 7 PM each night. There will be slack on, Friday and Saturday as needed.

## General Ground Rules

1. Only Identified workers, coaches, event directors and rodeo officials will be allowed in the arena. This will be enforced by the arena director.
2. If you are on the dirt, or fences of the Arena you must be in dress code, including wearing your vest.
3. Only contestants with a qualified ride/run will compete in the short round regardless of the amount of entries.
4. The arena will be closed—No Riding in the arena any time from April 8-11
5. No horses are allowed in the spectator area (around the bleachers, concession stand and bathrooms).
6. No filming from inside the arena or on the back of the bucking chutes.
7. Ties for each event will be broke by the fastest time or highest marked ride—if still tied by flip of a coin.
8. Current Coggins and health Papers are required to enter the grounds.

## Timed Events

1. Barrel Racers and Goat Tiers will enter the arena with an open gate on the run.
2. Goat Tying contestants may not leave through the center of the arena.
  3. Tie-Down, Breakaway will enter from the back of the box.
4. An escaped animal in the performance will be replaced by the extra.

## Rough Stock

1. Only contestants and coaches are permitted behind to chutes.
  2. Riders must exit the arena after their ride.
3. Only Identified workers, coaches, event directors and rodeo officials will be allowed in the arena.
