Performances will be Friday October 3rd at 7 pm and Saturday Oct 4th at 1:30 pm. Slack will be run each morning at 8 am and after the Performance Friday Night.

General Ground Rules

- Only identified workers, coaches, event directors and rodeo officials will be allowed in the arena. This will be enforced by the Arena Director.
- 2. If you are on the dirt, in our outside of the arena including all chutes, or in any part of the arena floor you must be in dress code, including wearing your vest. No sitting on the fence anywhere around the arena.
- 3. Only the qualified ride/run will compete in the short round regardless of the number of entries.
 - 4. Arena will be closed NO Riding in the Arena October 3rd 4th.
 - 5. No filming from inside of the arena or the back of chutes.
 - 6. Current Coggins are required to enter grounds.
 - 7. Steer Roping will be included for All Around Prizes.
 - 8. If Ties for Championships occur duplicate awards will be ordered.
 - 9. All Stalls and RV's are thru Open Stalls App.

Timed Events

- 1. Barrel Racers and Goat Tiers will enter the arena with an open gate on the run.
 - 2. Tiedown, Breakaway, and Team Ropers will enter from the back of the Box.
 - 3. An escaped animal in the performance will be replaced by the extra.

Rough Stock

- 1. Only Contestants and Coaches are permitted behind the Chutes.
 - 2. Riders must exit the arena after their ride.
- 3. Only identified workers, coaches, event directors and rodeo officials will be allowed in the arena.
