

Weatherford College Lone Star Region Rodeo

Ground Rules:

Weatherford College will host our inaugural NIRA Lone Star Region rodeo October 9-11, 2025 at the Parker County Sheriff's Posse Arena – 2251 Mineral Wells Hwy, Weatherford, TX. 76086. This year the Weatherford College Rodeo will be streamed by The Cowboy Channel on The Cowboy Channel+ app.

General Info

Rodeo Performances at **6:30 pm** Friday and Saturday nights.

Slack will be Thursday night **6:30 pm** and Friday and Saturday mornings at **9:30am**.

There will be live music after the rodeo Friday with Sonny Burgess, and Saturday with Rowdy Decker.

SOARS (supporting our area rodeo students) will provide Contestant, judges, and coaches Hospitality (food & drink) on the upper deck above the roping chutes.

VIP area Chute 7 on the upper deck above the bucking chutes. VIP pass required.

- Only identified workers, coaches, event directors and rodeo officials will be allowed in the arena.
- If you are on the dirt or fences in the arena you must be in dress code.
- Only contestants with a qualified ride/run will compete in the short round regardless of the number of entries.
- Current Coggins and health papers are required to enter the grounds.
- Contestants will need to park in designated areas on map. Coaches, and rodeo personnel may park behind the north grandstands close to the secretary office.
- **Contestants will not be allowed to tie horses to the parking lot fences nor build pens using the fence.**
- Stalls are free on a first come first serve basis as long as they do not have a lock on them.
- Steer Roping will be long go short go on Saturday after slack, points will count for All-Around and Team points for awards.

Format

6:30pm Thursday slack – BB, SB, BK, BR, TR, BA. Order may vary.

9:30am Friday & Saturday am slacks – BA, TD, BK, SW, GT, and TR order may vary.

6:30pm Performances – BB, TD, BK, SW, SB, GT, TR, BA, BR.

Timed Events

- Barrel Racers and Goat Tiers will enter the arena with an open gate on the run.
- Goat tying contestants may not leave through the center of the arena.
- If animal escapes during performances, the extra will be used.
- Goat score will be 120ft.
- Only the contestant up and the next 5 will be allowed in the arena during timed events and will need to huddle under the upper deck beside the head box.
- Contestants will follow their steer/calf out of the arena.
- Tiedown and Breakaway score will be 3' under.
- Team Roping score will be 1' under.

Rough Stock

- Only contestants, coaches, and video personnel are permitted behind the chutes.
- Riders must exit the arena after their ride.

Drags

- We will drag before and after 5 barrel racers in performances.
- We will drag after 5 barrel racers in slack. We will drag as needed during timed event slacks. Drag every 12 in goats.

Awards

- Kerry Kelley Bits to all timed event champions and Spurs to rough stock, All- Arounds, and Coaches. Capital Hatters 100X Felt to All-Arounds, Teams. Ties for each event will be broke by fastest time or highest score, if still tied flip of the coin.
