

11. ALL CONTESTANTS - All contestants must be wearing a school vest that is visible at all times upon entrance to Will Rogers Coliseum to gain access to restricted contestant areas, including: locker rooms, rodeo arena floor, stalling area, secretary's office and all rodeo related locations within Will Rogers Coliseum, whether competing or not. For security reasons, contestants may likely be asked for identification.
12. ALL CONTESTANTS – Arrival Information. ****DUE TO HEAVY LIVESTOCK EXHIBITOR TRAFFIC - DO NOT USE UNIVERSITY DRIVE WHEN ARRIVING OR DEPARTING****. Day haulers: From I-30, exit Montgomery St and proceed North. Turn East (right) on W. Lancaster and proceed East through University Drive to Trail Drive. Turn South (right) on Trail Drive. FWSSR Parking attendant will direct you from there. Night haulers- If you have purchased a stall, enter the grounds via Gate 35 at Trail Drive. FWSSR staff will provide further directions unloading horses and tack in stalls provided. Trailers must be moved immediately after horses and tack are unloaded.
13. ALL CONTESTANTS WITH HORSES - Must have Certificate of Veterinary Inspection issued within thirty (30) days and negative Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) test, also known as a "Coggins" test, within the past twelve (12) months. Proof of Coggins test must be presented in either the original document or copy of the original document that has been approved by the Texas Animal Health Commission. Test date, accession number and name of laboratory must be listed on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection. Exemption: Equine may enter shows, fairs, exhibitions or assemblies without a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection when accompanied by a valid equine interstate passport or equine identification card and a completed VA form 10-11 showing negative results to an official EIA test within the previous six (6) months.
14. STALLS – Stalls are available for purchase by contacting, Jasie Hatcher, Rodeo Assistant at (817) 877-2546. Horses must be stalled in assigned stalls, and are not to be stalled or tied to livestock pens or warmup arena panels.
15. FORMAT – All events. 5 total performances. All contestants will compete in one Long Go Round. Top 10 scores or times in each event will compete in the Short Go Round. Best on two will be the FWSSR College Rodeo Champion. Slacks will start with the barrel racing, and run order may vary from performance order. We will have a long go/short go in all rough stock even if we are below 15 entries.
16. ALL CONTESTANTS - No entry, including contestants with school vests, will be granted into the Rodeo arena beginning 1 hour prior to each round, no exceptions. All stock inspections must be performed in the arena pen area or timed event staging area. Contestant school vests must be visible at all times to gain entry into the bucking chutes, timed event staging areas, arena alleys/ staging area, rodeo arena and the Will Rogers Coliseum floor level.
