Law Enforcement Active Shooter Response – Decision Making

This is a new style of Active Shooter Training. Most Active Shooter Response courses are tactics focused. The problem with this is without regular training and re-training, tactics are extremely perishable. In analyzing past active shooter incidents and the police response, it is often not the tactics that are the problem in failures, it is the decision making. This unique class focuses less on the tactics of responding officers and more on the decisions made. There have been numerous examples in recent Active Shooter Incidents where officers' decisions on scene had a direct impact on a positive or negative incident resolution. In this class we will outline the best practices and lessons learned when responding to Active Shooter Incidents.

This class also touches on often overlooked topics such as hoax calls, multiple incident case studies and lessons learned, managing the aftermath, the "Pathway to Violence" and prevention, and EMS integration.

This is a classroom-based training. No special equipment required. The course is open to all sworn law enforcement officers.
