If you are dissatisfied with Salt Lake City's response to your request, you may appeal to the City's Chief Administrative Officer by filing a written notice with the City Recorder within 30 calendar days after the date of this letter, pursuant to Utah Code § 63G-2-401. The notice of appeal must state your name, mailing address, and daytime telephone number and the relief you seek. The City requests that you also include a copy of your GRAMA request, if applicable.
