Registration Night this year will be held on September 14th from 5:00pm-7:00pm.

Registration this season will be completely online, using the Curling I/O program. If you would like help completing your online registration, the club will have staff and volunteers present on Registration Night to assist with Curling I/O, along with a burger and a beer/wine for anyone who comes to register. Anyone who is registered will be entered automatically into the annual parking spot draw, which will be drawn on Registration Night.

Learn to Curl

The CCC will be hosting our yearly Learn to Curl Clinic on Friday, September 23rd at 6:30pm. The Clinic will run for 2 hours, including a brief ‘crash course’ lesson guided by certified coaches and a short game. All curling equipment is provided for use. Participants are asked to wear warm, athletic clothing and bring a clean pair of running shoes. Register ahead of time, since there is a maximum on-ice capacity of 48 people.

Members—feel free to share this information with others who may be interested in the sport of curling! Remember, if you refer a new league member to our club, your registration fees can be cut in half.
