#### What it is:

A Championship to determine the best champion from the lower mainland curling clubs.

#### Who is it for:

Each club will enter 4 teams that have qualified to play in the SLMCC. One of each: Men's, Women's, Open and Novice.

#### How to qualify:

You must win your league to qualify. Teams must play in a regular league together for no less than 10 weeks (5 weeks for Novice). No "super teams" aka you cannot pick random curlers to form a team.
