# Water Polo Stats Tracker Product Manual



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### The Game Statistics Page (Real-Time Tracking)

When you open the app for the first time you will find yourself on the Game Statistics page. If you don't wish to customize the players or statistics, you can begin using the app now.

The Game Statistics page is arranged in three sections. The top section has the score of the game (this is determined by adding up the goals for your team and the goals against for the opponent). The team names are text fields and you can edit them by clicking on them and using the keyboard popup to make edits.

The left section shows the player roster. The cap number and the player name will be displayed here. You must select a player to edit their statistics. A player selection is indicated by a gray background.

The right section shows the statistics being tracked. There are 4 items in each row; the "minus" button, the statistic's name, the current value for the statistic, and the "plus" button. The plus and minus buttons can be pressed to add or remove from each of the statistics.

Remember that these values apply only to the selected player. The value can not go below zero. (Tip: Each statistic is independent, so if "Goals" is incremented, "Shots" is not. You will have to increment "Shots" on your own.)

#### **Navigating the Pages**

To get from page to page within the app, you will swipe horizontally. The pages are arranged as follows from left to right:

Game Statistics <-> Game Summary <-> Data
Actions <-> Roster <-> Choose Statistics <-> About

#### The Game Summary Page

The Game Summary page shows the team totals for each of the statistics. All of the statistics are shown on this page, not just the ones selected for real-time tracking on the Game Statistics page.



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
## The Data Actions Page (Reseting and Downloading)

The Data Actions page allows you to reset the game, reset the app, or download the game data. Reset the game with the "Reset Game Data" button. After pressing this button, all of the statistic values will be reset to zero. Any player or statistics customization will be remembered. Reset the app with the "Reset All Data" button. This resets the app to its initial state. Everything is forgotten.

The "Export CSV" button will allow you to download a Comma-Separated Values (CSV) file. If you are unfamiliar, this is essentially a spreadsheet. The data has been arranged as shown in the screenshot. Each player has their own row and the bottom row (not shown) is the



team statistics. Open this in a spreadsheet program (like Google Sheets) and you're ready to go.



#### Saving

The app automatically saves. If you close the app, it will open as you have left it. There is, however, no method in which to save individual game files to pull up later. This is intentional. The app is meant to be simple and intuitive. Any record of games or analysis is intended for after you have downloaded the CSV. When the game is done, it's done. Make any changes later in the download file.

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#### **The Roster Page**

The Roster page allows you to customize which players are displayed and assign player names to the cap numbers. There are 20 available slots for players for any given game. You can maintain a team from game to game by using the "Reset Game Data" button on the Data Actions page.

To assign a name to a cap number, just tap the grayed-out "Enter Name" text and use the popup keyboard to enter the name.

To remove a cap number from the real-time tracking display, us the toggle button to unselect

that cap.

#### **The Choose Statistics Page**

The Choose Statistics page allows you to customize which statistics will show up on the real-time tracking display. This removes clutter from your tracker and makes recording stats easier. Use the toggle to choose which statistics you wish to turn on or off. Note that "Goals" and "Goals Against" can not be turned off. This is intentional because these two statistics are used to generate the team scores.

#### **The About Page**

The About page links to two resources provided by Water Polo Student. The first is the waterpolostudent.com website, where this document is housed along with other resources. The second link points to the Water Polo Student YouTube Channel, where you'll find a video detailing the use of this app as well as many other videos on water polo education.
