


Drive-Thru Food Give-AWay Event

We shared nearly 13,000 pounds of fresh produce from the St. Louis Area Food Bank, 9,000 pounds of pre-boxed non-perishable food items from Kirk Care and over 200 loaves of Great Harvest bread with our neighbors in need. Our "This is What Christ's Love Looks Like Drive-Thru Food Give-A-Way Event" helped over 180 families representing 580 household members of which 210 are children under 18 years old!
