Kirk Care had their booth again at spot number 6, where they got a great amount of traffic. Volunteers for Kirk Care manned the booth the entire


weekend. They passed out information about our services and explained the tax benefits of donating. Kirkwood City Hall again placed the Cutest Baby contest at our booth.




Donations Needed
