October 5th - Market Lake Clean-Up – Mark & Diane Schwarzenberger - No set date at this time, more information to come.

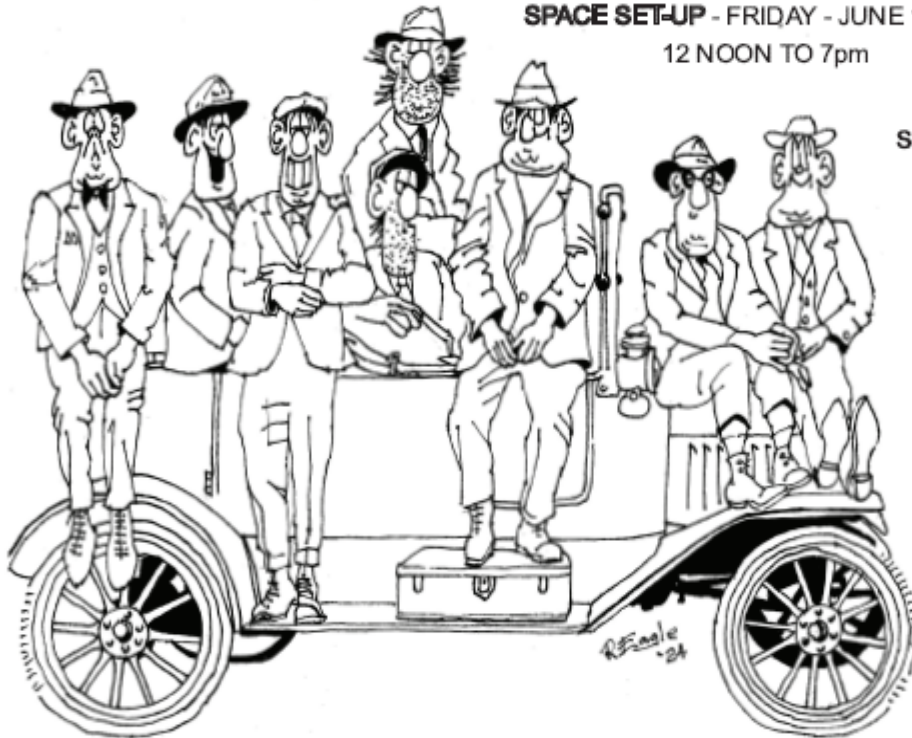
The meeting was adjourned. Snacks and drinks supplied by Mark and Diane Schwarzenberger.
