## Old Business

- Rhonda read the information from Joy for the *Some Like It Hot* regional tour to Lava Hot Springs, September 13-15. The flyer with all the details will be available in the next Gas Line.
- Swap Meet
  - The meeting with Parks and Rec went well. They will take down boards on the west side of the building (zoo side) for vendors to drive in and out, the east side overhead door will be opened with a personnel opening for people to enter the shelter, and the Zamboni door will be open with a ramp for handicapped persons.
