EIVMCCA Meeting Minutes – 5/14/2026.

The meeting was called to order by the President, Bob Thompson. There were fourteen members in attendance. The minutes of the April meeting were not read as a copy was not available at the meeting. Those minutes will be read at the June meeting along with the minutes from the May meeting. The treasurer provided the latest account information.

During the Market Lake cleanup on May 1, 2026 a proposal was made to change to one cleanup per year rather than the two cleanups presently done. After some discussion, a vote was held and the conclusion was to do the Market Lake cleanup once per year in the fall.

The President announced that the Regional Director, Bob Shilkett, is scheduled for additional surgery on May 19, 2026 and will be in recovery for several months. Doug Schwarzenberger reported one of the chapter's previous members, Ira Hall, was in hospice care after having his wife pass away a while ago.

The Treasurer then read the proposed changes to the Bylaws followed by a brief discussion on some editorial changes needed. Once those corrections were noted, a vote was completed and the revised Bylaws were unanimously accepted by those in attendance.

A status of the upcoming swap meet and car show was provided by Dawn Schwarzenberger. We presently have ten trailers and four tables spaced reserved, so far. Rhonda Schwarzenberger displayed the cards that will be provided to the vendors and car show participants which informs them about the EIVMCCA food booth, where the money for the booth goes, and offers a free cup of coffee or hot chocolate.

A vote was taken to adjourn the meeting. Treats were provided by Doug and Rhonda Schwarzenberger, and were enjoyed by all, along with some lively discussion.
