## Our Mission

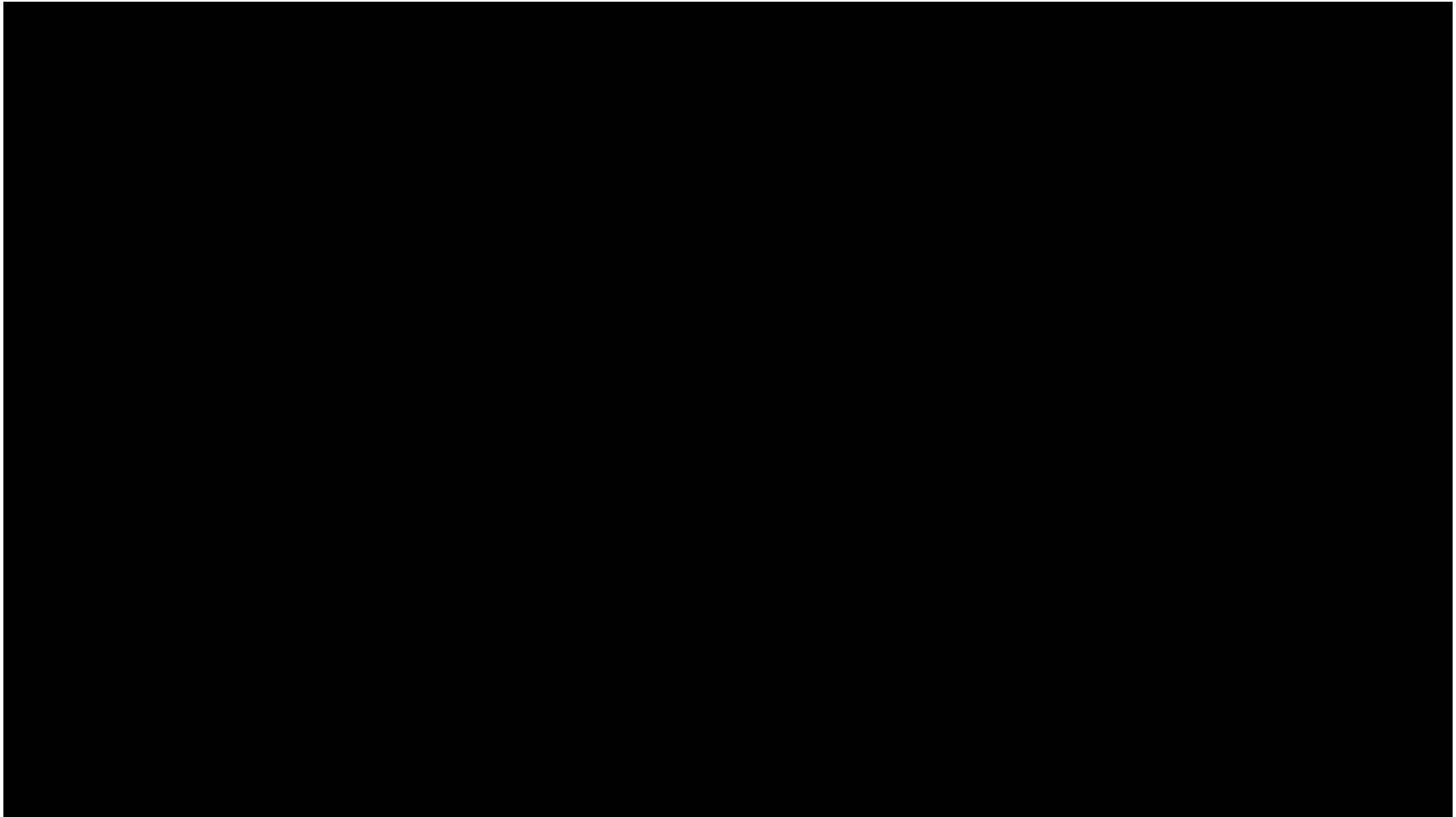
