Anyone failing to obtain a permit before starting work will be in violation of the CC&R's." If you have any questions, please call a permit committee member.

We have had some issues regarding fences. Please contact a Permits Committee member BEFORE installing your fence or any other changes to the exterior of your property. RECYCLE REPORT

We are very grateful for everyone who recycles. Thank you. In November we added \$138.25 for a new total of \$1,823.62 to date. Only one more month to get to \$2,000 for the year. Just \$176 more - we can do it! Don't forget to encourage all of your new neighbors to recycle with us! I think some are recycling already. Also thank you for separating **clean**, dry plastic from glass and aluminum, and for removing bottle caps to make it easier and faster for us. Don't forget to put those caps in the bag with the bottles tho. This month, we gave the City a lot of plastic that had moldy stuff in it, so please rinse if you can, or put it in your blue bin.

Remember that we can <u>NOT</u> get paid for plastic and/or glass bottles, or aluminum cans that had **any kind of food or oil** in them. Also thank you for **NOT** bringing <u>SCRAP</u> - i.e. solid white and/or solid colored plastic bottles for example yogurt drinks, Ensure, laundry detergent, bleach, etc or ANY cleaning product container. No plastic juice and/or large opaque milk & water bottles, **UNLESS they have CRV on them. Note that juice plastics from Dollar Tree are not CRV...** No liquor bottles unless marked CRV. Wine and beer bottles can be sold, but not liquor bottles. Please put those in your blue City recycling bin.

YES to <u>clean</u>, dry containers such as all aluminum beverage cans; plastic ice tea; glass soda, beer, wine bottles and anything else marked CRV or California Redemption Value.

Note that juice plastic from Dollar Tree is not CRV...

Drop off your bags over the west gate at 3639 North Way or **call/text Lynette 760-717-9121** if you need a pick up or have a question. Don't forget to take some empty bags when you drop off. Many just had water bottles in them. There's usually enough for your neighbors too!






