To prepare your landscape, front and back yards, for the rainy season, some attention should be given to improving drainage, clearing debris, and maintaining your irrigation system. Depending on your location in Costa Serena, you might need to clean gutters and drains, mulch, and potentially add rain gardens or an area designed to collect and filter rainwater runoff. Pruning low-hanging branches, aerating the soil, and adjusting your rock surface configuration.

Further information regarding permits: "According to our policy and procedures, it is not only required but it is mandatory to have written approval from the Architectural Committee for all exterior changes before any work may begin. Anyone failing to obtain a permit before starting work will be in violation of the CC&R's." If you have any questions, please call a permit committee member.

RECYCLE REPORT

Thank you, thank you, thank you to all of you who recycle! In August we added \$232.49 - our best month this year! New 2025 total is \$1,322.17. Heading toward \$2,000 for the year. Let's do it!

Don't forget to encourage all of your new neighbors to recycle with us! I think we have some of them recycling already. Also thank you for separating clean, dry plastic from glass and aluminum, and for removing bottle caps to make it easier and faster for us. Don't forget to put those caps in the bag with the bottles tho.

Remember that we can **NOT** get paid for plastic and/or glass bottles, or aluminum cans that had **any kind of food or oil** in them

Also thank you for **NOT** bringing SCRAP - i.e. solid white and/or solid colored plastic bottles for example yogurt drinks, Ensure, laundry detergent, bleach, etc or ANY cleaning product container.

No plastic juice and/or large opaque milk & water bottles, **UNLESS they have CRV on them. Note that juice plastic from Dollar Tree is not CRV...**

No liquor bottles. Please put these in your blue recycling bin.

YES to clean, dry containers such as all aluminum beverage cans; plastic ice tea; glass soda, beer, wine bottles and anything else marked CRV or California Redemption Value. **Note that juice plastic from Dollar Tree is not CRV...**

Drop off your bags over the west gate at **3639 North Way** or call/text Lynette **760-717-9121** if you need a pick up or have questions.

Don't forget to take some empty bags when you drop off. Many just had water bottles in them. There's usually enough for your neighbors too!

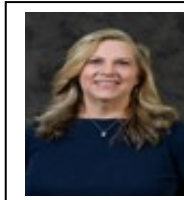
