CHAIR REPORT

Dear Neighbors,

Thanks to all of you that were able to attend our April meeting. Although the weather was "iffy" we had a very nice turn out. Our speaker, Sherry Gangel, gave a very good presentation on getting organized with some excellent tips and short cuts. At our July meeting we will have speaker discussing other ways to improve our homes. (More info next month.)

Costa Serena Garage Sale: Another reminder that our community garage sale is scheduled for June 14, 15th and 16th. So, we all need to get our "stuff" ready for sale.

I've noticed that there are a few of you that are still displaying **political signs** in your front yards. As stated in our last newsletter political signs are allowed to be displayed **90 days prior to an election and must be taken down 10 days after that election**. The next election is not until November!!! If you need clarification or help in taking down the signs, please give me a call.

If your neighbor's trees are hanging over your property and that neighbor declines to have them trimmed, you have the right to trim the limbs that are on your property or call a professional to trim them. I did.

Initiative: This is exactly what a resident on Gail was using while trying to get the property owners or city to clean up the empty lot behind Gail. There has also been a problem with homeless people hiding in the bushes. She is not taking any excuses from anyone and expects and "demands" results. You go girl!!! It is so refreshing to have a resident actually take on a problem themselves. She has been keeping me in the loop along the way. I am so impressed by her tenaciousness as we all should be. Thank you so very much.

Last week I noticed a dog (grey schnauzer) on North Way without a leash and no owner in sight. Worried that it was going to get hit by a car, I started down my street to see if he had a collar on and he promptly did his business and scratched dirt and debris on the sidewalk and ran to his home on North Way. This is so wrong in so many ways. Where was the owner and does the owner let this happen all the time? The City of Oceanside will fine owners that do not pick up their pet waste. The first citation is \$100 and the 4th and subsequent citations will be \$1,000 for repeat nuisance animals/owners.

Election: We will be mailing out ballots to be received the middle of May. There are two committee seats to be voted on - Age Compliance and Treasurer. Their bios will be on the ballots. We also have two vacant committee positions open — Permit and Landscape. Please consider volunteering for a position on the committee. We need volunteers to help with the counting of ballots on the morning of June 8th. For obvious reasons the committee does not assist with the count.

Please keep your porch lights on. My neighbor told me that he saw a flatbed truck casing our neighborhood recently. We really need to be vigilant and aware of anything unusual happening in our neighborhood. Keeping your porch lights on will help deter any criminal activity.

RECYCLE REPORT

April's recycling added \$241.64 to our account for a year-to-date total of \$704.05. That's better! Some who donated have moved away, so don't forget to encourage your neighbors to recycle with us!

Also thank you for separating clean, dry plastic from glass and aluminum, and for removing caps to make it easier (and faster) for Mark and me. The recycling company pays less for containers with liquid in them so we empty them. Don't forget to put those caps in the bag tho.

And yay – liquor/wine bottles are being recycled for MONEY again, altho they aren't paying much for them.

Remember that we can <u>NOT</u> get paid for plastic and/or glass bottles, or aluminum cans that had **any kind** of food or oil in them

Also thank you for not bringing **SCRAP:** aka solid white and/or solid colored plastic bottles for example yogurt drinks, Ensure, SlimFast, laundry detergent, bleach, etc or ANY cleaning product container. No plastic juice and/or large opaque milk & water bottles, UNLESS they have CRV on them. **Please put these in your city blue recycling bin,** since it takes a **huge bag** to make a quarter!

YES to clean containers such as all aluminum beverage cans; plastic ice tea; glass soda, beer, wine and liquor bottles and anything else marked CRV or California Redemption Value.

Drop off bags over the west gate at 3639 North Way or call/text Lynette 760-717-9121 if need a pick up.

Don't forget to take some empty bags when you drop off. Many just had water bottles in them. There's enough for your neighbors too.

MINUTES OF COSTA SERENA GENERAL MEETING

Held at Sharon Martinson's Patio; Saturday April 13, 2024 at 10:00 AM

Minutes of last meeting approved by: Barbara Hillery and 2nd by Sharon Martinson

Meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairperson went around and had everyone introduce themselves. Then she mentioned we have a speaker today, Sherry Gangel of Bee Organized.

John McDonald from Buena Hills spoke about how he goes door to door canvassing for political purposes. He feels there's a difference between political and commercial canvassing and he won't go to any home that has a sign that says No Soliciting or Trespassing. Sharon said we may or may not all agree with that. And, that's a disclaimer. Sharon also mentioned that canvassing and soliciting are one and the same. She looked up and she has the paperwork.

Mary talked about the Welcome Center located on Coast Highway and 76. They have lots of information about California and Oceanside. They are open Monday to Saturday 10-4.

Sharon introduced Gary Conklin who has lived in our community for over 20 years. He was a caregiver for his mother and when she went into Hospice, he became friendly with the workers and has remained friends with them. He has arranged for a Hospice social worker for our meeting in April of 2025, a year from now. Many people are not familiar with how Hospice works and this would give them the opportunity to learn more about it.


