CHAIR REPORT

Dear Neighbors,

The end of the year is approaching rather quickly, but there's still time to make a donation to Costa Serena. Your donations make it possible for Costa Serena to remain a 55+ community, which we all enjoy.

Speaking of remaining a 55+ community, we do have some residents that feel they are entitled to rent out either a portion of their house or a room to people under 55. These people are totally out of compliance with our CC&Rs. Barbara Hillery, who is our Age Compliance Committee Member, reminded all of us of the CC&Rs regarding these rentals. She quoted the following CC&R, Section 3.4, which is as follows:

"Short Term Rentals Prohibited / Acceptable Rental/Lease Terms. Lease or rental terms for a Lot shall be for a period of at least thirty-one (31) days or more. Lease or rental terms of thirty (30) days or less (i.e., short term rentals) are strictly prohibited within the Development. Owners shall provide new tenant or new resident information, including name, address, and age verification, to the Committee prior to the tenant(s) occupancy."

Scammer Alert:

You have all seen them in our neighborhood and some of you have actually opened your doors to them and listened to their pitch. No wonder people think "seniors" are gullible. We have said it time and time again that it is illegal to allow solicitors in our neighborhood, but some of you keep allowing their presence. The scammers I'm talking about are the solar energy scams.

AARP had an article about the "Clean Energy Scams Surge". The article listed a "How to Dodge These Scams.

1) Watch for importors. Solar accommers may say they're from your power company, utilities were. Ask for ID.

- 1) **Watch for imposters.** Solar scammers may say they're from your power company, utilities warn. Ask for ID. 2) **Do not sign or initial papers** of electronic devices on a cold call or before reading contracts and documents.
- 3) Slow down and do your own research. Don't get pressured into signing or giving away personal info.
- 4) **Keep personal information private**. Don't give away personal data to anyone who contacts you about a green energy opportunity."

I did my research on the company that sends their minions to our neighborhood. I checked them out on BBB and they had 4,410 complaints in a three year period and 1,424 in a 12 month period. AND you wonder about their credibility. Think about it – in a 12 month period it's 118+ complaints per month. Always do your homework. You wouldn't buy any other purchase from someone going door-to-door. These people know that Costa Serena is a senior community and prey on our gullibility. Please do not be that Gullible Senior Citizen.

Further information regarding permits: "According to our policy and procedures, it is not only required but it is mandatory to have written approval from the Architectural Committee for all exterior changes before any work may begin. Anyone failing to obtain a permit before starting work will be in violation of the CC&R's." If you have any questions, please call a permit committee member.

RECYCLE REPORT

In October we added \$222.75 to our account, for a YTD total of \$1,743.77. Good month recyclers!

Thank you for separating clean, dry plastic from glass and aluminum, and for removing caps to make it easier (and faster) for Mark and me. The recycling company pays less for containers with liquid in them so we empty them. Don't forget to put those caps in the bag tho.

Remember that we can **NOT** get paid for plastic and/or glass bottles, or aluminum cans that had **any kind** of <u>food or oil</u> in them

Also thank you for not bringing **SCRAP:** no solid white and/or solid colored plastic bottles for example yogurt drinks, Ensure, SlimFast, laundry detergent, bleach, etc or ANY cleaning product container

No plastic juice and/or large <u>opaque</u> milk & water bottles, UNLESS they have CRV on them. **Please put these in your city blue recycling bin,** since it takes a **huge bag** to make a quarter!

YES to clean containers such as all aluminum beverage cans; plastic ice tea; glass soda, beer, wine bottles and anything else marked CRV or California Redemption Value.

Just drop off your bags over the west gate at **3639 North Way or call/text Lynette 760-717-9121** if you need a pick up and/or have questions. Don't forget to take some empty bags when you drop off. Many just had water bottles in them. There's enough for your neighbors too.


