### ***Landscape***

To help keep Costa Serena looking its best and safe for everyone, we'd like to remind residents that trash cans should only be placed out the night before or the morning of scheduled pickup—placing them out days in advance is not acceptable. Please also be mindful of your landscaping and ensure plants, vines and ground covers (especially invasive species), are not encroaching into neighboring properties or jutting out into the sidewalk areas. Lastly, keep sidewalks in front of your home clear of debris so all residents, including those using electric wheelchairs, can move safely and comfortably throughout our community.

Thank you for your cooperation and care for our neighborhood. January is a great month in North County San Diego to tidy up and prepare the landscape for spring. Focus on light pruning of roses, deciduous trees, and shrubs, removing dead or damaged growth while avoiding heavy pruning of spring bloomers. Clean up fallen leaves and debris, refresh mulch to retain moisture and suppress weeds, and check irrigation systems for leaks or adjustments needed after winter rains. It's also an ideal time to pull winter weeds while the soil is moist and apply compost to garden beds to improve soil health for the growing season ahead.

Further information regarding permits: "According to our policy and procedures, it is not only required but it is mandatory to have written approval from the Architectural Committee for all exterior changes before any work may begin. Anyone failing to obtain a permit before starting work will be in violation of the CC&R's." If you have any questions, please call a permit committee member.

We have had some issues regarding fences. Please contact a Permits Committee member **BEFORE** installing your fence or any other changes to the exterior of your property. ## RECYCLE REPORT

It's been a good year for Costa Serena, thanks to all of you who donate; not just recycling, but also money. THANK YOU! December recycling added \$191.35 for a grand total of **\$2,014.97** for this year. WOW! Don't forget to encourage all of your new neighbors to recycle with us!

Also thank you for separating clean, dry plastic from glass and aluminum, and for removing bottle caps to make it easier and faster for us. Don't forget to put those caps in the bag with the bottles though.

Remember that we can **NOT** get paid for plastic and/or glass bottles, or aluminum cans that had **any kind of food or oil** in them. Or for any containers with stuff still in them.

Also thank you for **NOT** bringing SCRAP - i.e. solid white and/or solid colored plastic bottles for example: yogurt drinks, Ensure, laundry or dish detergent, bleach, etc or ANY cleaning product container.

No plastic juice and/or large opaque milk & water bottles, **UNLESS they have CRV on them. Note that plastic juice containers from Dollar Tree are not CRV...** No liquor bottles unless marked CRV. Wine and beer bottles can be sold, but not liquor bottles. Please put those in your blue City recycling bin.

**YES** to clean, dry containers such as all aluminum beverage cans; plastic ice tea; glass soda, beer, wine bottles and anything else marked CRV or California Redemption Value.

Drop off your bags over the west gate at **3639 North Way** or call/text **Lynette 760-717-9121** if you need a pick up, or have a question. Don't forget to take some empty bags when you drop off. Many just had water bottles in them. There's usually enough for your neighbors too!

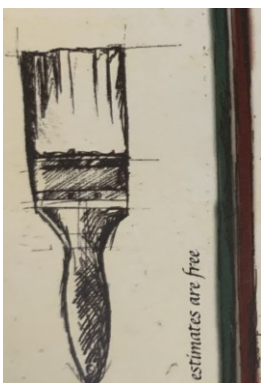

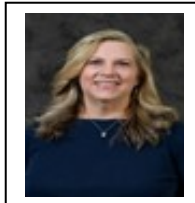
