



FOR ADULTS (over 18) feel free to include your contact information (mail or email) if you'd like to give them an option to reply.

Important reminder All letters go through a screen process before they are sent, therefore envelopes are not needed.



Clay Santa Finishing – Class Prep by Beth Stodieck, ã2025

SUPPLIES: Regular acrylic painting supplies plus:

Clay Santa or other wood surface of your choice (use the pattern that fits your surface best)

Flat brush, small round brush, very good quality tiny liner brush for eyes. Excellent quality drybrush of your choice. Whatever you are comfortable with is the best choice. I will have a few of my favorite drybrushes to loan out if you'd like to try them.

PAINTS: I will have all the paints available for sharing at the Chapter Meeting

Cool White Titanium White

Blue Harbor Storm

Navy Blue (or favorite blue for eyes) Grey Sky Wild Berry (or your favorite blush color) Bt Sienna

Warm Beige (or your favorite flesh color)

Tuscan Red (or your favorite Santa red) Fiery Red Neon (optional)


Cranberry Wine (or shadow color of your choice for the red you've chosen)

CLASS PREP:

Use Storm for all edges and for any background areas on the painted Santa. Basecoat all Beard, Mustache, Hair and Hat Fur with a 50/50 mix of Blue Harbor and Grey Sky.

Basecoat Face flesh color of your choice including nose.

Basecoat Eyes with Titanium White


