

STEPS FOR MAKING A GOOD CONFESSION

- 1. Examine your conscience by using the questions provided and reflecting on your sins.
- Say "Bless me, Father, for I have sinned. It has been [say the amount of time: weeks, months, or years] since my last confession. These are my sins."
- Tell your sins to the priest, who is there taking the place of Jesus. He is there to hear your sins and give you God's forgiveness.
- 4. When you have finished listing your sins, the priest will offer some advice. Listen to him carefully. He will then give you a penance.
- 5. Say the Act of Contrition.
- 6. Listen as the priest prays the Prayer of Absolution (this is the moment when your sins are forgiven). Make the Sign of the Cross when the priest does the same.
- 7. Return to your pew and pray your penance.

ACT OF CONTRITION

O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended Thee, and I detest all my sins because of Thy just punishments, but most of all because they offend Thee, my God, who are all good, and deserving of all my love.

I firmly resolve, with the help of Thy grace, to sin no more, and to avoid the near occasion of sin. Amen.

FIRST COMMANDMENT

I am the Lord your God. You shall not have strange gods before me.

Do I love God above all things or have I made other things (clothes, sports, TV, music, pleasure, peer approval) more important than God?

Do pray every day? Do I pray only when I need something or do I also thank God, too?

Have I put trust in superstitions or good luck charms, or do I trust in God alone?

Do I make a serious effort to learn more about my faith?

Have I ignored any Church teaching or denied that I am a Catholic? Do I pick and choose only the parts of God's message that I like?

SECOND COMMANDMENT You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.

Have I used the names "God" or "Jesus" carelessly or in anger?

Have I used bad language?

Have I wished harm on someone?

Have I been disrespectful to the Blessed Virgin Mary, the saints, the Church or those who have consecrated their lives to God?

THIRD COMMANDMENT Remember to keep holy the Lord's Day.

Have I missed Mass on Sunday or any holy day of obligation through my own fault?

Do I arrive at church late or leave early without serious reason?

Am I reverent and pay attention during Mass? Do I avoid unnecessary work on Sunday?

FOURTH COMMANDMENTHonor your father and your mother.

Do I try to bring happiness and peace to my family?

Do I respect and obey my parents?

Have I dishonored or mistreated my parents or members of my family with my words or actions?

Do I help around the house or must I be reminded?

Do I try to get along with my siblings? Am I a good example for younger siblings?

Do I respect others in authority: parents, teachers, coaches, etc?

Do I make time to visit my relatives?

FIFTH COMMANDMENT You shall not kill.

Have I been violent toward others with my words or actions?

Do I intentionally harm my own body?

Do I say mean things, or make fun of others? Have I stopped speaking to anyone or failed to forgive someone?

Do I hold grudges or try to get even with others?

Do I get angry easily or lose my temper?

Do I encourage others to do things I know are wrong?

Have I harmed animals, littered or been destructive to the environment?

Do I try to love all people, born and unborn?

SIXTH COMMANDMENT You shall not commit adultery.

Do I treat my body and other people's bodies with respect?

Do I watch shows, movies, videos or pictures that are sinful or that don't respect the human body?

Am I modest with my words and the clothes I wear?

Do I talk to others in a way that does not respect God's gift of sexuality?

Do I treat others as objects with my words or actions?

Have I failed to keep myself pure?

SEVENTH COMMANDMENT You shall not steal.

Have I been greedy or jealous of things other people have?

Do I resent others' popularity or success?

Have I taken things that were not mine?

Have I destroyed or misused another person's property?

Do I return things that I borrow?

Have I wasted time, goods or food?

Do I share what I have with those in need?

EIGHTH COMMANDMENT

You shall not commit false witness against your neighbor.

Have I kept my promises?

Did I break a secret or a confidence?

Am I honest in my work at school or at home?

Do I tell lies to make myself look good or to protect myself from punishment?

Do I tell lies that make another person look had?

NINTH COMMANDMENT

You shall not covet your neighbor's wife.

Do I allow my parents to spend time with one another, or do I get jealous and want them to pay attention only to me?

Do I get mad when I have to share my friends? Are there people I will not be friends with or am mean to?

TENTH COMMANDMENT You shall not covet your neighbor's goods.

Am I jealous of other people's things or abilities? Am I thankful to God and my parents for what they have given me?

Do I share the things I have with my family, friends and with the poor?



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
