### Tip of the Month

Sometimes fisherman only think about which lure to use and forget about the most important item: the line. When was the last time a fish actually spooled your entire reel? Line can be expensive, especially with the use of a good fluorocarbon. To save a few dollars, use monofilament line for a few hundred feet on your spool and then tie your more expensive line at the end. Check frequently for nicks, clip off several inches of line and retie often, and always store your line in a dark place with a moderate temperature.

## Catch of the Month August 2009


