*We offer Tournaments to all members during Events when noted above. It's not required that you participate in the Tournaments. All Participants in the Tournaments are required to provide a copy of their Boat Insurance and sign a Waiver prior to the Tournament start.

Major Changes Come to Tournaments

This year we will have 9 Events with 14 Tournaments offered to Members who want to participate. It's not required that you participate, but if you want to compete for Angler of the Year, you need to participate in the Tournament during the Event. Below is a highlight of the Major Changes to Tournament Fishing during our Events.

1) Honor System – No longer will it be required that you have a witness for your catch. Each Member will sign their own scoresheet and certify their catch. This will help Members that don't have a partner for the Tournament able to still participate without having to hold their fish in a live well or take pictures. We are fishing for fun (keyword: "Fun") and not for the big paycheck at the end of the Tournament.

2) All Boat Owners must provide Proof of Insurance and all Participants must sign a Waiver prior to fishing in the Tournament.

3) Members are allowed to fish with Non-Members. Since no Witness is required, Members will be allowed to fish with whoever they like. However, it's encouraged to have another Member fish with you. This will allow Members to bring family members, neighbors and friends to help promote the Club and spread the word that our Club is here for all and not a "Hardcore" Tournament Club.

4) Members are allowed to have a Non-Member participate as a Guest twice a year. Unlike being able to just fish in the Tournament with a Member, the Non-Member will also be able to participate for "Bragging Rights". The Non-Member will not be able to participate for Angler of the Year. We are hoping this will help bring in new members by showing Non-Members how our Tournaments work while having fun on the water.

All of these changes are being made to help retain participation in the Tournaments and promote the club to others.
