

Become a volunteer when you are 14 years old




Did you know...

That plants are living things which we call organisms at the farm?

Yes, they are... As living things, they breathe just like us humans and if they did not breathe, then humans and animals would not be able to survive on planet earth. Plants are that important that they grow all over the planet – on land and even in our oceans!

They provide us with fruit and vegetables and fresh air to breathe.

#### Do you know the steps to growing your own plant?



At Stonebridge City Farm we have three polytunnels and having these helps to protect the baby plants from the environment. This is really good at the beginning of spring when the weather starts to get warmer and the days become longer.

#### Why not grow a sunflower from seed?






#### There are many varieties of fruit and vegetables


Did you know...
