# Instructions

## Here's a simple recipe for a Homemade Blueberry Muffins

Things you will need:

110g  
unsalted  
butter



250g  
caster  
sugar



2 eggs



250g  
plain flour



1/2 teaspoon  
of salt



125ml milk



2 teaspoon  
baking soda



225g blueberries



## Wash hands before beginning

- 1) Pre-heat the oven to 180 degrees Celsius or gas mark 4
- 2) Grease the inner sides and base of the muffin tin or create a line of 12 paper cupcake cases on a baking tray
- 3) In a bowl, mix together the flour, salt and baking powder and leave aside until later (Tip: this will save you doing it later on)
- 4) In another mixing bowl, combine the butter and caster sugar until the mixture is fluffy and light
- 5) Crack the 2 eggs into the mixture and beat them thoroughly
- 6) Add in the milk and the premade flour, salt and baking powder mixture and beat until all is combined
- 7) Now, add in the fresh blueberries and stir them in
- 8) Fill the muffin cases with the mixture 2/3 to the
- 9) Finally, bake in the oven for 25 – 30 minutes (use a toothpick to poke the muffins after 25 minutes of baking. If it comes out clean then the muffins are ready)

**Now finally, once cooled... enjoy!**
