

Activity: Flash Cards/Timeline



Supplies:

- Flashcard and timeline template
- Scissors or tape
- Gluesticks

Instructions:

1. Print out the flashcard and timeline templates. Cut along the outer black lines leaving the date and text attached by the center black line for each flashcard (do not cut this line). Fold along the centerline so that the date and text are on opposite sides. Then glue or tape the two sides together.
2. Review the flashcards and then practice guessing which year each event took place.
3. After you have practiced, see if you can lay the flashcards out on the timeline in the correct order without looking at the date side of the flashcards.
4. Once you have read and placed all of them on the timeline you are finished! You now have made a Civil rights timeline! Share your timeline with your family members and tell them what you learned about the Civil Rights Movement!
