COSIS Code of Conduct

When a player agrees to become a member of COSIS, they agree to meet the standards of conduct and behavior set forth by the club. The club standards are based on the premise that Family, Faith and Friendship = Fellowship. The following rule addresses the penalty for not meeting club standards.

Ejection Rule

A player may be ejected from a game for any of the following infractions:

Forcible physical contact
Excessive, unacceptable language
Verbal abuse
Excessive arguing

On the first offense the player will be given a warning by the club. If a second offense occurs the player will be ejected from the game.

If the foul is considered to be flagrant, the player will be immediately ejected and must leave the building. Failure to immediately leave the building will result in the team forfeiting the game.

An ejected player's position in the batting order will be an out for the remainder of the game. If a team starts a game with nine players and a player is ejected for conduct that player's position in the batting order will be an out for the remainder of the game. If an additional player is ejected for conduct, leaving seven players the game is forfeited.

Any individual that continues to show behavior or conduct unacceptable by the club will be suspended permanently from the club without reimbursement.
