And if my parting left a void, Then fill it with remembered joy A friendship shared, a laugh, a kiss, Ah yes, these things I will miss.


Be not burdened... deep with sorrow, I wish you all sunshine tomorrow My life's been full, I've savoured much, Good friends, good times... A loved one's touch.
