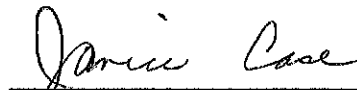

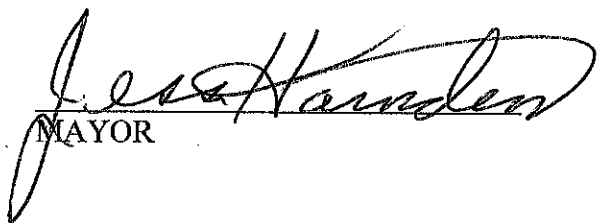

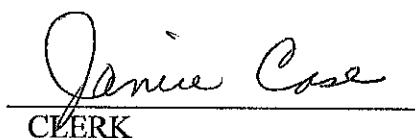

Tom Moore from Tri-State Engineering brought a map of CDBG Storm Water Improvements and explained the lay out of the target areas for the proposed Storm Water Improvements. The inkind labor cost for the city for the CDBG Storm Water Improvements will be \$59,000.00. The city will charge wage plus benefits for prevailing wage value for work done by city employees towards the city's pledge. Work done by the Public Works Department may include moving fire hydrants, moving water lines, clean ditch, work on sidewalks, install handicap ramps, final clean up, seeding, raking and mulching. 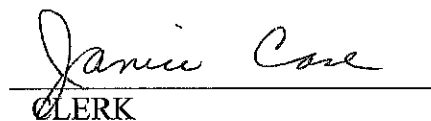

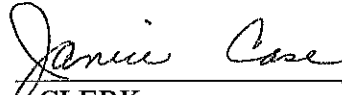

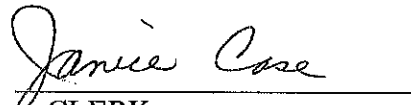
WORK SESSION
