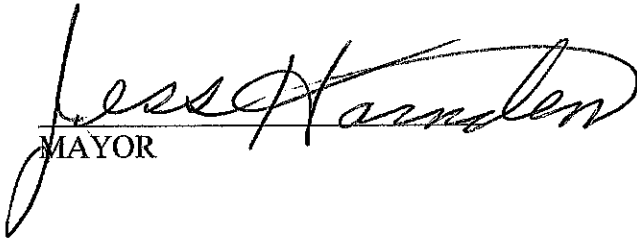

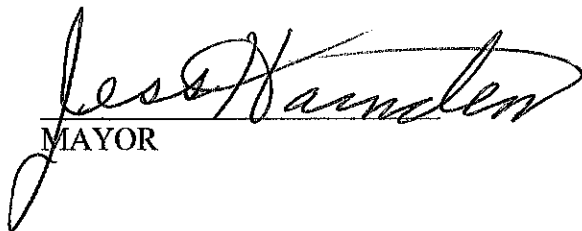
Mayor Jess Harnden called the Public Hearing to order. Those in attendance were Johnny Arrowood, Angela Madden, Roger Koch, Shirley Almandinger, Betty Pearson, Virginia Furry, Wesley Bivens, Glen Davidson, Earl Shofler, Karen Brill and Thelma Sapp. The purpose of the Public Hearing was to discuss the upcoming Bond Election for the expansion of the 201 Sewer Board. Glen Davidson from Allgeier Martin & Associates Inc. explained why the expansion project is needed. The cost of the Center Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant Expansion Project would amount to \$4,000,000; the cost to Carterville would be 14.6% for a total cost of \$580,000. The cost to customers would be \$5.68 for the first 100 cubic feet and \$1.15 for each cubic foot after the first 100 cubic feet. The bond issue will appear on the April 8, 2003 election ballot. The Public Hearing adjourned at 7:15 p.m.
