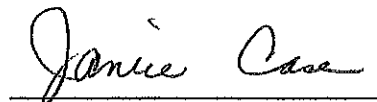

Doug Miller, the city attorney explained that the city collected the full amount entitled to collect because of a bond debt service to improve sewer systems.
