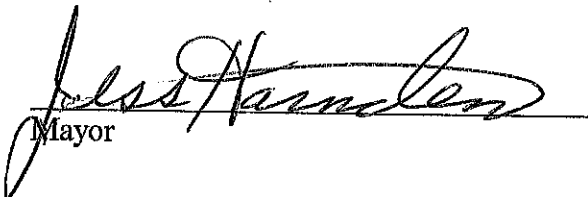

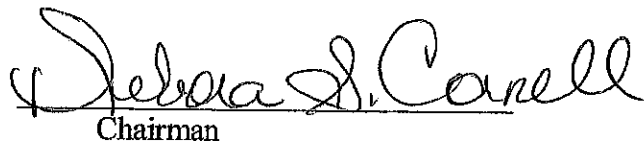

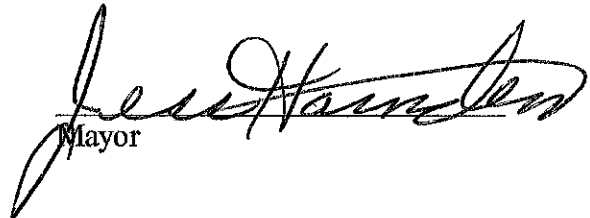
Chief Cline told the council that the police would patrol 1 day a month with a city worker to pick up stray animals.
