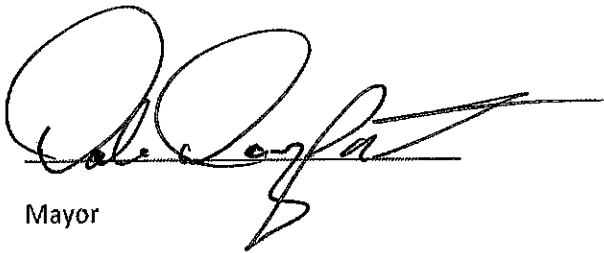
The board discussed that prices for vendors should increase from \$10-\$15 to \$15-\$25 depending on rather they wanted electric or not. The group agreed unanimously.

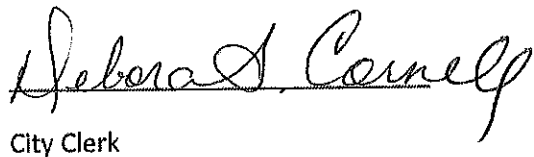

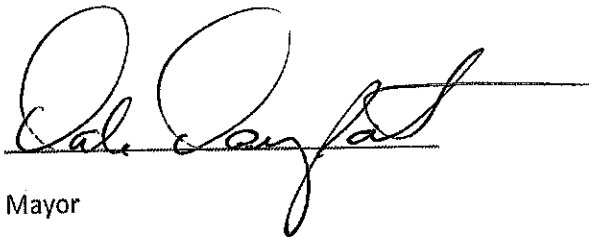
Will updated the board on the air conditioning and Garrett park progress.

At this time the group mutually decided to hold off on setting the next meeting due to scheduling conflicts.

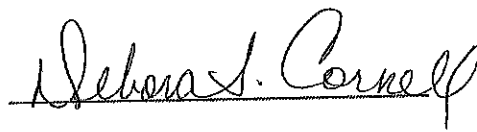
