It took Alliance Pump 3 trips to fix the well.

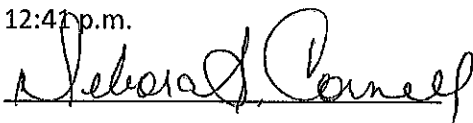

The dump truck needs repairs and is out of service until the repairs are made. Kolbee Southard will run rock and hot mix until the dump truck is back.

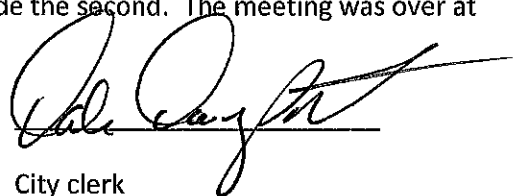

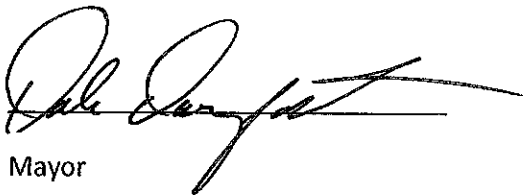

Alley of Fountain and Wilson there is a sewer collapse and it is 20 feet deep. Southard Construction has been called in for the digging so our employees can get the repairs done.

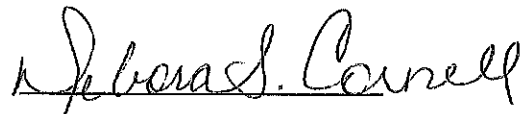
