Reference: Training Schedule and Cost

April 18-19, 2000: Basic Police Driving in Warrensburg at the Missouri Safety Center. Lodging costs are \$20 for one night. Class costs are \$180 per officer and mileage if paid. Sgt. Cornell is scheduled to attend.

May 8-9, 2000: Basic Police Driving at the Missouri Safety Center. Costs are listed above. Officer Beasley is scheduled to attend.

May 8-12, 2000: Type II Certification for the BAC at the Missouri Safety Center. Lodging costs are \$20 per night. Class costs are unknown at this time and mileage if paid. Sgt. Cornell is scheduled to attend.

May 22-23, 2000: Type II Certification Practical at the Missouri Safety Center. Lodging is \$20 per night. Cost for the class is included in the above class and mileage if paid. Sgt. Cornell is enrolled.

May 16-17, 2000: Tactical Response to Methamphetamine Labs is being offered in Joplin. There is no cost for the class with the exception of payroll. Sgt. Cornell, Officers Beasley and Harrison have been placed on the waiting list. No change has been indicated as of 03-23.

Standard Field Sobriety Testing is available through the Safety Center. The class is funded at no cost to Missouri POST Officers. Cost would be for lodging (\$20 single or \$30 double) and mileage if paid. Chief Kitch, Officers Beasley, Harrison, and Hamilton have requested enrollment. No date has been announced as of 03-23.
