The committee discussed the offensive smell coming from Fleming Grease and whether they are operating with out a city business license. Doug Miller will be contacted to see what procedures can be taken.

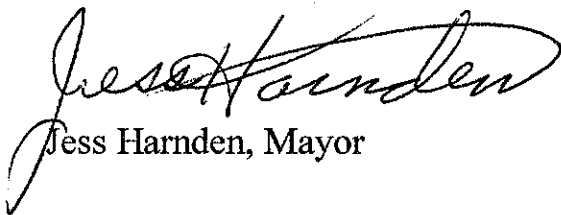
Betty Pearson made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:45 p.m. Shirley Almandinger second. Motion carried.
