

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AMENDMENTS TO THE CITY CODE BOOK.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARTERVILLE, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Carterville makes the following amendments to the City Code Book.

Section 100.110. Convenience Charge For Transactions Made By Debit or Credit Card.

- (A)1. Convenience charges are collected by a third party company and set by contract.
- (A)2. For any transaction made by debit or credit card within the Carterville Municipal Court, Water Department, City Administration, City Collector and all other departments within the City of Carterville, a debit/credit card convenience charge shall be set by current third party company.
- (A)3. For payments made for cash bonds by debit or credit card within the Carterville Police Department, a debit/credit card convenience charge set by current third party company shall be assessed for each transaction.

Section 110.240. Conduct of Council Meetings.

- A. A City Police Officer shall attend all meetings.
- B. Meetings of the city council will be guided by best practices from "Robert's Rules of Order" when conducting business.
- C. The Mayor of the city shall direct the meeting and set the agenda.
- D. This Section shall not apply to any subject of business scheduled for a public hearing.

Section 125.390. Holidays

C. All employees not required to work on a holiday shall be paid straight time for the 8-hour holiday at their current rate of pay. Those employees who do work on holidays will be compensated for additional hours worked beyond the 8-hour pay. Since the employee is not required to work on the holiday, the hours spent off the job shall not be considered as "working times" as defined by the Fair Labor Standards Act.

Section 140.300. Established —Police Board  
Change all references in this section to "committee"

Section 140.010. Established — Park Board  
Change all references in this section to "committee"

Section 110.190. Time and Place of Regular Meetings

The City Council of the City shall convene no less than once per month to conduct city business. Meeting date and time should be agreed on by consensus of the Council and keep consistent to allow attendees as well as Councilpersons to avoid conflicts in scheduling. Whenever any such day shall fall on a City holiday, the meeting shall be held on the next succeeding business day, unless otherwise provided.

Section 500.055. Additional requirements to National Electrical Code.  
City requires 3A copper wiring to mast on new construction or upgrade.

Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Ordinance by and on behalf of the City of Carterville.
