

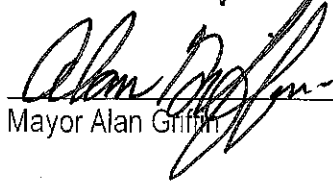
PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES

Hearing was the zoning change of 2 acres to the West of 301 East Lewis from R2 to Commercial. John Henkle told the Council that the only concern that the Planning and Zoning had was if he had to have a large truck bring in glass that Lewis Street is not paved for large trucks. Cody Franks told the Council he was extending his driveway off of Pine for the trucks to make his deliveries. 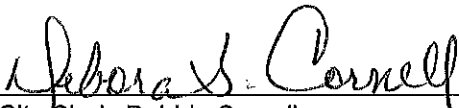

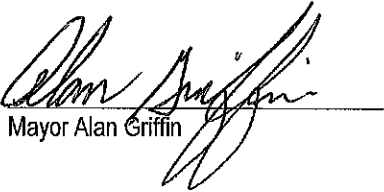
