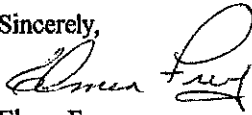

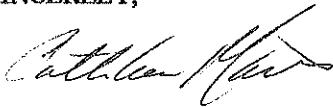

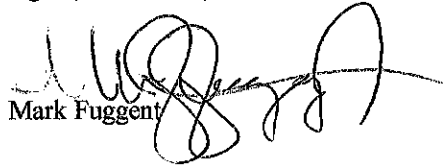

VISITORS SHARED THEIR CONCERNS:

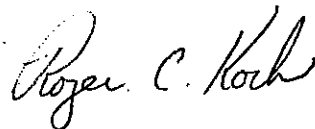
*RON VANN - MR. VANN SAYS THAT HE HAS BEEN ON BOTTLED WATER ALONG WITH CITY WATER. HE WANTED TO ENSURE THAT HE WOULD BE REIMBURSED FOR BEING ON THE BOTTLED WATER. ELMER FREY AND JESS HARNDEN TOLD MR. VANN THAT HIS NAME HAD NOT BEEN MENTIONED IN ANY OF THE PREVIOUS MEETINGS CONCERNING THE E.P.A. (CONTAMINATED WELLS). JESS HARNDEN TOLD MR. VANN THAT IT WOULD BE BEST IF HE CONTACTED CLIFF DRAKE OR JOHN BOLTE (RURAL WATER PERSONS) TO ENSURE THAT HE IS ON THE E.P.A. LIST. MR. VANN ALSO WOULD LIKE HIS METER MOVED CLOSER TO HIS HOME.

*JOHN YATES - MR. YATES IS HAVING DRAINAGE PROBLEMS AT HIS HOME AT 518 OAK (END OF ZINC). HERB PUT DRAINAGE WHISTLE IN AT AN ANGLE THAT DOES NOT ALLOW THE WATER TO FLOW. ELMER SAID THAT RON OR SOMEONE FROM THE WATER DEPT. WOULD BE OUT TO LOOK AT THE PROBLEM. JESS HARNDEN WILL ALSO LOOK AT THE PROBLEM.

*SHANE DUNCAN - MR. DUNCAN SAYS THAT HE IS 2 MONTHS BEHIND ON HIS WATER BILL. HE HAS BEEN OUT OF A JOB FOR 3 WEEKS AND HAS NOT BEEN ABLE TO PAY ANYTHING ON HIS BILL. HE SAID THAT HE WOULD BE ABLE TO PAY 1/2 OF THE BILL (\$28.55) ON FRIDAY 12/17/99 AND THE OTHER 1/2 (\$28.55) APPROX. 1 WEEK LATER. PUBLIC WORKS AGREED THAT IF MR. DUNCAN PAYS 1/2 OF THE BILL NO LATER THAN 12NOON ON FRIDAY 12/17/99 THAT WATER WILL REMAIN ON. IF MR. DUNCAN DOES NOT SHOW UP TO PAY 1/2 BILL BY 12NOON ON 12/17/99 THE WATER WILL BE SHUT OFF. MR. DUNCAN ALSO SHARED CONCERNS ABOUT HIS DRAINAGE. HE LIVES AT 601 TENNESSEE.

*RICK VANN - MR. VANN WOULD LIKE TO HAVE HIS METER MOVED APPROX. 6 FEET TO MAKE ROOM FOR HIS DRIVEWAY. ACCORDING TO RICK VANN, HIS WATER METER IS LOCATED BESIDE RON VANN'S WATER METER. PUBLIC WORKS SAYS THAT WHEN RON VANN'S METER IS MOVED, THAT RICK VANN'S METER CAN ALSO BE MOVED.
