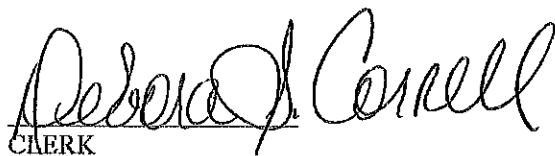


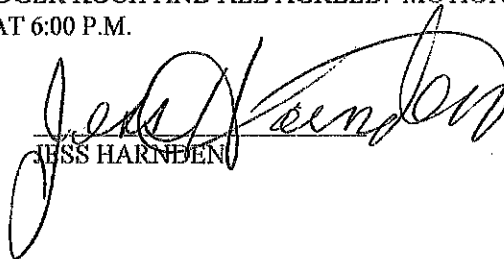
PUBLIC HEARING
CARTERVILLE COUNCIL

ROLL CALL THE CITY COUNCIL CONDUCTED A PUBLIC HEARING ON AUGUST 28, 2000 IN CARTERVILLE COUNCIL CHAMBERS WITH MAYOR JESS HARNDEN PRESIDING. THE MAYOR CALLED THE PUBLIC HEARING TO ORDER.
