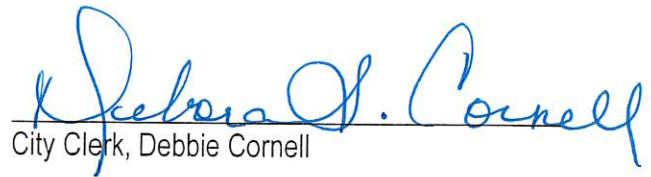
Mayor Alan Griffin opened the Public Hearing for the 2020 Tax Levy.
