

**RESOLUTION & ORDER  
FIREWORKS DISCHARGE & CLEAN-UP**

**WHEREAS**, residents of Split Rock Township have raised concerns with the discharge of fireworks from Township roads and right-of-ways pertaining to fire danger, noise, nuisance, and injury and concerns with debris (litter) resulting from the discharge of fireworks; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to SDCL 8-2-1, the Board of Supervisors of Split Rock Township may make resolutions and orders for the protection of the lives and property of its inhabitants as they deem to be in the best interests of the Township residents; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED & ORDERED**, by the Split Rock Township Board of Supervisors, Minnehaha County, South Dakota, pursuant to SDCL 8-2-1, that effective June 13, 2018, no fireworks shall be discharged from any Township road or right-of-way; and


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED & ORDERED**, by the Split Rock Township Board of Supervisors, Minnehaha County, South Dakota, pursuant to SDCL 8-2-1, that effective June 13, 2018, anyone who discharges fireworks in the Township limits shall within 24 hours after discharge clean up all debris and litter related to the firework discharge; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED & ORDERED**, that the term "fireworks" used in this resolution shall mean pyrotechnics or fireworks containing phosphorous, sulfocyanide, mercury, chlorate of potash and sulfur or chlorate or potash and sugar, and the following named fireworks:


Firecrackers, flash crackers or salutes, blank cartridges, cherry bombs, skyrockets, including all devices which rise in the air during discharge, roman candles, including all devices which discharge balls of fire into the air, chasers, including all devices which dart or travel above the surface of the ground during discharge, snakes, boa constrictors, bottle rockets, snake nests containing bichloride of mercury, all articles of pyrotechnic display which contain gun powder, articles commonly known as son-of-a-gun, devil-on-the-rock, cricket sticks and automatic torpedoes which contain arsenic, explosives known as devilon-the-walk, or any other article of similar character which explodes through means of friction, or by fuses, and all other fireworks, except cap pistol paper caps containing not more than twenty-five hundredths grain explosive compound to each paper cup.

"Fireworks" for purposes of discharge does not include items known commonly as "sparklers", snakes, snaps and smoke balls.
