

APPROACH BY DELNA

- 1. Advocacy, awareness raising, research
 - (open data, conflict of interest, political party financing, anti-money laundering, lobbying transparency, transparency of public procurement etc.)
- 2. Whistleblowing and whistleblower protection
- Monitoring and capacity building of law enforcement institutions
- 4. Alliance Against Corruption in Latvia (busines integrity)


CAPACITY BUILDING AND EDUCATION



- 1. <u>Professional training</u> for 600 officials from 30 law enforcement and control institutions on aspects of tackling corruption, shadow economy and money laundering. *In cooperation with Latvia's Public Administration School, academics, lawyers and Prosecution Office.*
- 2. <u>E-learning module</u> for public officials in cooperation with Corruption Prevention and Combating Bureau (KNAB) and Public Administration School.
- 3. <u>Summer school</u> for civil society on monitoring public procurement and EU funds with involvement of KNAB.
- **4.** <u>Training</u> on developing effective internal whistleblowing channells in institutions.
