



Dear Parent(s),

We are the Victorium Chapter of the Punishers Law Enforcement Motorcycle Club. Our mission is to be *"In Service To Others"* by providing volunteer and charitable support within our local communities. Our chapter name, **Victorium**, reflects our commitment to helping students rise above bullying and create safer school environments.

One of our key initiatives is the **Victorium Anti-Bullying Campaign**, which we bring directly into local schools. Many of our members have personal experiences with bullying, some as former victims, others as individuals who have grown to understand the harm their past actions caused. These experiences fuel our dedication to educating, supporting, and protecting today's youth.

We have been invited into schools to speak with students about bullying, its impact, and the importance of empathy, accountability, and community. Our goal is to help prevent bullying, support those affected by it, and reach students who may be engaging in harmful behaviors by offering guidance and positive mentorship. Ultimately, we aim to help create a school environment where every student feels safe, respected, and able to learn without fear.

As part of this effort, we have developed the **Victorium Anti-Bullying Student Support Program**. Each participating school will nominate five students to serve as official Support Members. Each student will be paired with a sponsoring Victorium Chapter Brother who will act as a trusted mentor and point of contact.

With parental permission, students may reach out to their assigned mentor for advice, feedback, or support regarding situations at school. When appropriate, the sponsoring Brother will communicate concerns to school officials to help address and prevent bullying incidents.

Support Members will receive a small backpack, a campaign T-shirt, and a journal. Students will be encouraged to write a brief personal biography, reflect on the kind of



person they hope to become, and complete at least five good deeds per month, documenting their experiences in their journal. Once a month, a Victorium Chapter Brother will meet with the Support Members during lunch to discuss their good deeds, peer support efforts, and ways to continue promoting a bully-free school environment.

This program does **not** involve students in any form of physical intervention. Students are encouraged only to stay aware, support their peers, and report concerns. All formal reporting and follow-up will be handled by our chapter in coordination with school administrators.

With the support of parents and school leadership, we are committed to making a meaningful, positive impact on students and their school communities.

To allow your student to participate, we ask that you complete the attached consent form and email it to **(ADD EMAIL)**. As a parent, you will also receive contact information for your child's assigned Brother. Communication may occur by phone, email, or text, and we want to assure you that you will be aware of all communication between your student and their mentor. There is **no cost** to participate. This program is our way of giving back to the communities we serve.
