Following the major impact of the 2015 Child Care Crisis, our founding providers banned together to spread awareness on the effects that governmental decisions were having on the industry and ultimately the many children and families in our state. They continued their efforts in spreading the word about C-CAP and other essential programs that were offered for the City's most vulnerable communities.

As the organization began to grow, as did it's purpose. Today CCAU serves to amplify the work and needs of community based child care organizations throughout the State of Illinois, We advocate for equity, parity and inclusion throughout the child care industry. CCAU also works hard to expand our resources in order to continue to empower and support providers and their businesses by delivering educational workshops and wrap around services.

SUPPORTING THE CHILD CARE INDUSTRY

CCAU over the years has sought out the guidance and voices of the many women and men that push the child care industry. In 2017, many providers expressed concern regarding the need for more Type 4 teachers in centers, and after hard work and a push from then Senator Toi Hutchinson, SB 1829 was created, pushed and passed through congress.

This year CCAU tackled another issue, the financial vulnerability and hardship of families during the COVID-19 pandemic. With the support and charge of Rep. Lashawn Ford, we were able to push for House Bill 141 to be filed in legislature. HB 141 advocated for families who were eligible for child care services at income levels at or below 185% of the federal poverty line, allowing them to pay a \$1 co-pay for child care services. This bill also advocated for businesses by putting providers on a level playing field with district schools moving the system towards equity, and eliminating the burden from providers who need to choose between terminating services for non-payment or the financial stability of the program.

In addition to the legislative efforts, CCAU steered efforts administratively as well. Nourishing and establishing relationships with administrators by sending letters and connecting virtually to express and address the concerns that were shared during this time. In these spaces we were heard and many concerns were addressed with major changes in administration.

SUPPORTING PROVIDERS & FAMILIES

CCAU has held multiple workshops this year to benefit both providers and their families in development,

One of our first workshops and seminars for the summer of 2021 was a credit workshop, geared towards providing participants tools to use for understanding credit scores, raising credit and important related information. We were happy to hear that participants found it very helpful and shared information with those in their networks. "I think this will be a great training for colleagues and other forums."

In support of provider development CCAU also held a 501c3 Workshop designed to assist those who were interested in learning about the process of becoming a recognized non-profit. Months following CCAU partnered with Morgan Stanley to create and provide customizable 401k Plans for member center's employees. The goal was to help ensure that our fellow provider businesses remain compliant under the new secure choice act mandate set to change in 2022, "We appreciate the time spent putting this informational webinar together!"

Throughout the new year we will continue to think of ways to build bridges and fill any informational gaps that may occur in our industry. We want for all CBOs to be aware and prepared!




January 2021-December 2021
