


Figure 1. Visualization of global happiness based on perceived generosity.

In the below graphic, a relationship between Global GDP and Global Cities by Revenue (in billion USD). In order to better illustrate the individual, human nature of the World Happiness, the dots of each city is transparently displayed by number of employees. The color ramp of the cities illustrate darker cities being more valuable and lighter cities being less valuable.




Figure 3. Global Regions and Economies

Looking at Figure 3, we may reasonably conclude there are far less Global cities in sub-sahara Africa compared to China.




Figure 4. Freedom to Make Live Choices vs Global Perceptions of Corruption
